

Examination Results 2019-20

All of our students make us proud everyday with the progress they make socially and academically. This year our very pleasing external examination results reflect the hard work undertaken by our students during unprecedented times.



Please remember when reading these external examination results they do not demonstrate the full picture of achievements our students have made. We are equally proud of the social progress our students have made, the work experience undertaken, the independence developed and self-regulation learnt.

Our cohort sizes are small (13 students in Year 11 in 2019-20) meaning that the performance of just one student can significantly alter any trends seen in data. The fact that floor standards do not apply to special schools is clear recognition of the very limited relevance of these measures to our provision. The Attainment 8 and Progress 8 measures only take into account GCSEs and a small number of BTEC qualifications and focus on the expected performance of students in mainstream schools.

To ensure students maximise their potential and become accustomed to the rigors of the examination process we offer students the opportunity to sit formal qualifications before the end of KS4. This year several students from year 10 achieved Entry Level and GCSE qualifications a year early. In English 5 students sat their GCSE with two students surpassing their end of KS4 target. Within Maths 5 students took GCSE a year early with two students surpassing their target grade and two students achieving their KS4 target grade. 4 students sat science a year early with one student surpassing their KS4 target.

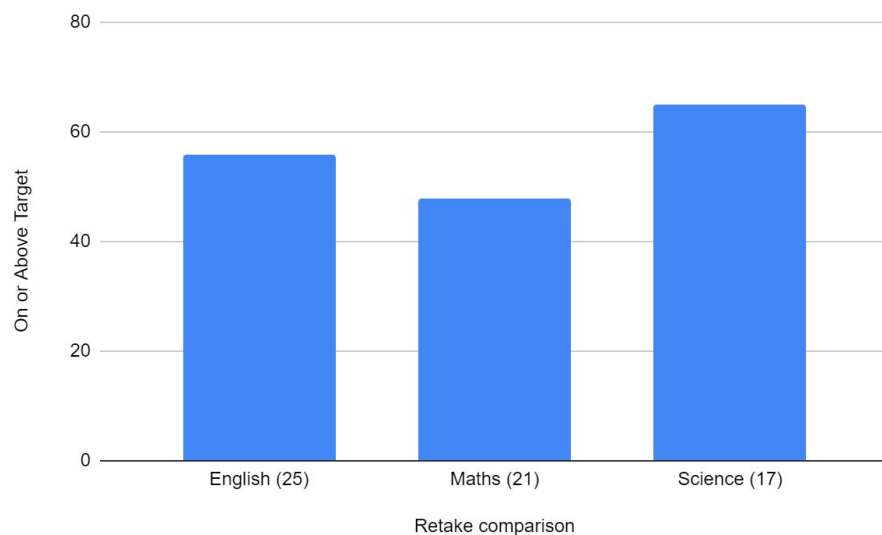
Pleasingly every student in the Year 10 cohort has achieved at least one formal qualification a year early. This helps increase expectation and develop a resilience to the examinations process which will benefit the students over the coming years.

We are really pleased to share the success our Year 11 students have achieved across a wide range of qualifications. 12/13 students achieved at least 1 GCSE qualification. 8/13 students achieved at least 5 GCSE or equivalent qualifications. 7 students achieved Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award. 100% of students made us proud of how they developed socially and emotionally, how they supported each other and faced the challenges put in front of them.

Sixth Form



This year sixth form students have undertaken GCSE resits in English, Maths and Science. The number of resits is indicated next to the subject on the bottom of the graph. In all three subjects over 50% of students matched or bettered their target grades. Three students in English, two students in Maths and one in Science have achieved at least a grade 4 GCSE opening up a variety of progression routes.
