Spring 1	Component 1 Islam	Life as a Shi'a Muslim /Sunni Muslim in Britain and in Iran. Six articles of Faith/ Five roots of Usal ad-Din. Importance and nature of Allah and Mohammad. Holy books - Sunnah and Hadith, Qu'ran. Festivals in Islam – Ramadan and Sawm - how and why are they celebrated? Mosque and pilgrimage. Salah and Jumu'ah , Jihad.
